HOUSE BILL 197

AN ACT relative to the use of deadly force in defense of another.

ANALYSIS

This bill permits the use of deadly force against another person in circumstance where deadly force is used in the commission of felony against a person in a vehicle or in the commission of riot against a person within such person's vehicle, dwelling or its curtilage.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty One

AN ACT relative to the use of deadly force in defense of another.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 Justification; Physical Force in Defense of a Person. Amend RSA 627:4, II(c)-(d) to read as follows:

(c) Is committing or about to commit kidnapping or a forcible sex offense; ~~or~~

(d) Is likely to use any unlawful force in the commission of a felony against ~~[the actor within such actor's]~~ ***a person in a vehicle***, dwelling or its curtilage; ***or***

(e) Is likely to use any unlawful force in the commission of riot against a person in a vehicle, dwelling, or its curtilage.

2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
